To apply follow these steps.

Held rain or shine!

STEP ONE: Determine if you meet our criteria and want to enter this pre-juried art fair.

What is our criteria? It's easy. All of your work must be of original design. No kits, resale items, or imported items.

You'll need to submit 2 slide/photo representations of work to be juried for acceptance.

You will need fees and a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE)

Make sure you can follow Steps Two, Three and Four!

On the day of the fair, a donation of your work for the KAA Annual Art Auction is appreciated.

STEP TWO: Send in your completed application with fees, SASE by APRIL 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006. Late entries are placed on a waiting list. List description of artwork accurately and bring only what you have listed on your application. We reserve the right to ask you to remove anything unacceptable. Call for questions: 262-654-0065

#### STEP THREE: Wait for your application to be accepted, placed on a waiting list, or rejected.

There are a limited number of spaces - approximately 100. Again, all work is juried by a panel for acceptance. We pick the cream of the crop! (Please, no complaints or threats against the Fair if you are not accepted!)

- If you are accepted, a confirmation card will be sent to all accepted, juried applicants by May 5<sup>th</sup> in your SASE. You will receive your pre-assigned space. There will be *no refunds* after acceptance and *no rain date* is scheduled. Please call if you are registered but unable to attend due to unforeseen circumstances.
- If you are placed on a waiting list, a card will be sent to you stating you will be notified if a space becomes available, by the second week of May. Your fees will be returned if a space does not open in time for the fair.
- *If you are rejected:* Fees will be returned to all applicants who are not accepted, along with your slides/photos in your SASE envelope.

#### STEP FOUR: What to do and know the Day of the Fair – Sunday, June 4, 2006:

- 1. There will be *no refunds* after acceptance and *no rain date* is scheduled. Please call if you are registered but unable to attend due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 2. Please Check In and verify your pre-assigned space number, plus pick up your packet upon arrival, after 8 a.m. The Kenosha Art Association Information Booth will be located in the center island section.
- 3. Set up is between 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. There will be a continental breakfast with beverage for all exhibitors.
- 4. Bring your own props, tables and chairs. Space size: 12 ft. x 12 ft. (Approx. 100 spaces available)
- 5. There is NO PARKING on Sheridan Road-not even for unloading to set up. Use 56<sup>tth</sup> or 57<sup>th</sup> Streets, or 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- 6. <u>Please park vehicles in the Reuther High School lot after unloading</u> (57<sup>th</sup> Street & 10<sup>th</sup> Ave SW of park). Leave side streets open for customer parking! Exhibitors who do not move their vehicles to the Reuther lot will not be re-invited.
- 7. Please, No early breakdown. Fair is held rain or shine. When you do breakdown, please clean up your space. Thanks!
- 8. Regular and handicap-accessible restrooms available 24 hrs/day at the Kenosha County Safety Building (one block north of the park). Portable restrooms available all day in Civic Center Park.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for liability within their space as well as any loss, theft, or damage. (Be prepared for wind.)
